Collection

Your ICT equipment will be collected on site by our trained staff. All of our vehicles are fully tracked and secured to ensure your equipment is safe whilst in transit and accounted for when it arrives at our premises.

Data Security and Data Destruction

With SE Recycling you can be certain that all your data is erased and can never be accessed again. We ensure that all items are fully tracked through all stages of our recycling process. The information from laptops, computers, and ICT equipment is wiped using government approved Blancco dataerasing software, all in a secure environment.

Staff are trained to be diligent in seeking out and destroying all data in compliance with GDPR and ISO:27001 regulations.

Reuse

To comply with our policy of zero landfill, the items we collect are checked by our team of experts to determine if they can be repaired, refurbished and where possible put back in to society as cost effective solutions and/or donated to charity.



Data Destruction





When disposing of any ICT equipment the greatest concern for an organisation is the corporate and personal information contained within them. Redundant ICT equipment is a rich hunting ground for those looking to exploit any opportunity when it is not processed properly.

Our highest priority is the destruction of all your data on any media device and to ensure that it is securely and safely destroyed to the highest level, compliant with industry standards.

At SE Recycling we will:

- Use government approved Blancco software to securely wipe and erase all data bearing equipment.
- Deliver a certificate of data destruction at the end of each project confirming details of all items processed.
- Provide a full asset management service detailing asset serial numbers.

We will always work with our customers to agree the most suitable options for providing the most secure and best value service.

The methods we employ are:

- Data Sanitisation: using the latest government approved Blancco software we permanently and irreversibly remove data stored on any media device.
- Hard Drive Shredding: Computer hard drives are physically cut into small pieces.
- Degaussing: the process of exposing media devices to a powerful magnetic field.
- **Punching:** a quick and easy way to destroy the hard drive by punching a hole through it.

All of SE Recycling's methods and practices are 100% compliant with GDPR, ISO 27001 and NCSC Government guidlines to ensure that all your assets are safe and secure at each step of the journey.



IT Remarketing

Computers & Desktops

For many businesses this is a great opportunity to raise funds for a chosen charity and in doing so we have successfully raised money for a number of charities including Teenage Cancer Trust, Amnesty International and Claire House Children's Hospice.

To ensure we achieve the maximum impact in all we do we have developed the IT2Schools Initiative, aimed at teaching the next generation about the importance of sustainability and helps equip students with some of the necessary business skills to progress in the world of work. The initiative has successfully involved over 1000 students across the North West.

Our policy of working with local people from challenging backgrounds has enabled us to maintain an excellent staff retention record. As a result of our work with schools, SER was invited to sit on the Greater Manchester Chamber of Commerce (GMCC) Careers and Skills Advisory Board. SER are regular contributors to the Careers, Education, Information, Advice and Guidance group (CEIAG) across Manchester. In recognition of our work with the local community we have been awarded consecutive level 2 bronze social value awards by the GMCC. In 2019, SE Recycling was recognised by the Federation of Small Businesses (FSB) as one of the Ethical-Green Businesses of the Year.

SER has invested time in giving the long-term unemployed work experience, training and jobs. In return, local people have given us their time to learn and gain experience in our industry. The technical staff we employ are all from our local community with various challenging backgrounds including disabilities and ex-offenders.



Creating a Sustainable Environment





Electronic waste is the second largest waste stream in the UK and is growing at an alarming rate. In the UK alone we produce on average 1.5 million tonnes of ewaste a year, of which only 17% is actually recycled. It is now crucial that we try to reuse and recycle ICT and electronic equipment whenever possible to ensure we have a sustainable environment.

At SE Recycling we are committed to protecting the environment. We believe there is never any need for IT equipment to end up in landfill and be a problem that has to be dealt with by future generations.

This is why we prioritise reuse over recycling. By focusing on refurbishing and reusing assets we can help reduce the amount of energy that comes with having to dismantle older equipment and re-manufacturing the new.

With assets that cannot be reused we will break these down and recycle them ensuring nothing goes to landfill. Precious metals can be extracted from ICT equipment when recycled, reducing the need for raw material mining and use of natural resources.

In 2020 we were awarded the Carbon Hero Award in recognition of our recycling efforts.



Our Support for Schools





At SE Recycling, we are passionate about educating the next generation on the importance of recycling and its impact on the environment. Our IT2Schools Business Enterprise Initiative supports the Department for Education 16-19 study programme ensuring quality work experience is a key component of a student's education.

Students are tasked with creating, developing, and implementing an ICT Recycling Project with the aim of generating money for their school and / or a local charity. The IT2Schools initiative teaches students key employability skills in communication, presentation, marketing, finance and analysis. These key work ready skills help the students prepare for the future in employment or in creating their own business.

Bringing business and education together helps students understand the importance of sustainability and the positive impact it has on the environment. With this, we hope that future generation carry on the positive message of sustainability and help create a better future for all.

To date, over 1000 students have participated in the IT2Schools Business Enterprise Initiative, raising funds for a number of charities.
